## REMINDER: BENEFITS WHEN RE-ENROLLING DURING MARCH

There are two periods with a gradual discount depending on the month in which the re-registration is paid:

RE-REGISTRATION	DISCOUNT
June re-registration cost	Without discount
Re-registration cost in April and May	18.6% discount on June cost
Re-registration cost in February and March	Discount of 33.3% of the June cost

Re-registration payment can be made in cash or transfer (discounted fee) or with bank cards (normal fee) in a single payment.

If you choose payment by bank credit card, it can be deferred for 6 months without interest (except BBVA and Banamex), paying the cost that appears in the normal installment.

The integrated fee can be made in a single payment or divided into 3 identical consecutive monthly payments depending on the payment method chosen.

This can also be paid by credit card and there is the possibility of choosing 6 months without interest with most credit cards (except BBVA and Banamex).

Please consult the cost circular that you received in recent weeks to be clear about the amounts to be paid.
