



## ROY'S CIRCLE

### FOR FOREIGN DADS AND MOMS WHO DON'T SPEAK SPANISH

The following project is intended for all foreign parents of the Lakeside community who reside in our country and do not speak our Spanish or English, with the aim of creating a social circle that allows for coexistence and the exchange of experiences to forge new bonds.

A school community has as its main objectives to encourage those who are part of it to have a strong sense of belonging, to communicate effectively with those around them, and to improve coexistence. Additionally, it provides significant benefits such as:

Socializing with moms and dads of their age. Helps them to have greater self-confidence and be less timid, as participation makes them feel supported by the rest of the community.

Learning to listen to and respect the opinions of others, leading to healthy dialogue.

Increased motivation to learn and to understand the ideas and opinions of other community members.

The Roy's Circle project is designed in 3 stages outlined below:

#### STAGE 1 LANGUAGE DEVELOPMENT (NON-VOCABULARY)

This stage aims to lay the groundwork for communication among our foreign dads and moms in Lakeside. Creating a bridge through empathy, allowing us to be truly perceptive while building lasting bonds. We will delve deeply into the life context of foreign dads and moms, sharing what they have experienced so far in Mexico and their thoughts on it. Each session will end with a small phrase to help them learn to communicate in Spanish. It's important to note that initially, the sessions will focus on integrating the dads and moms because they are newcomers.



## STAGE 2 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT

This stage aims to carry out the integration process of each of the dads and moms to become active and participatory members of Lakeside. Generating contact networks where professional and entrepreneurial moms and dads come together to form business relationships, create and develop business opportunities, share information, and seek potential clients.



## STAGE 3 BONDS & NATURALIZATION

Monthly discussions will be held with some Mexican families from Lakeside, either at the school or elsewhere in recommended spaces, to establish a stronger connection and continue expanding groups. We will discuss a movie or book to develop an understanding of other tastes and interests. Additionally, families participating in the Roy's Circle will share something about their country, customs, and traditions with others to enrich and build bonds.



Roy's Circle will have a monthly cost of \$6,500 per participant (8 classes per month). Interested foreign dads and moms will have a 1-hour class on Mondays and Wednesdays from 3:00 pm to 4:00 pm. During that time, they can leave their children at the school, and they will join the class scheduled during that time in the Afterschool program (cost included in the monthly fee of Roy's Circle). The cost of Roy's Circle will be the same whether they attend alone or with their children.

For foreign dads and moms interested in Roy's Circle, we will organize a breakfast where the project will be explained in detail.
